# Updated: COVID-19 Pfizer Vaccine expanded to ages 12 and Older

# What is new?

On May, 2021, the <u>Food and Drug Administration (FDA)</u> issued Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) for the use of the Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine for ages 12 years and older.
